IMMEDIATE ACTIONS

If bitten, scatched or any skin lesion

- Wash the affected area with soap and water for at least 5 minutes before rinsing with clear water.
- **Disinfect** for at least **5 minutes** using:
 - **Dakin's** solution (sodium hypochlorite 0.5%, bleach 2.6% diluted active chlorine 1/5)
 - 70% alcohol

In case of skin contact

• Wash immediately with clear water from the tap or the security shower for at least 5 minutes.

Splashes in eyes

- Rinse thoroughly with plenty of clear running water for at least 5 minutes, hold eyelids wide open, head tilted back with the affected eye looking downwards.
- Contact lenses tend to get washed away on their own, do not try to manually remove them.
- Do not use any collyre or eye solution.
- Always consult an ophtalmologist.

Urgently consult the referring doctor:

- In order to assess the infectious risk of HIV, HBV, HCV, other infections (see the contact details on the conduct sheet to be maintained in the event of AES on the site).
- Report your vaccination status (hepatitis B, tetanus, monkeypox, rabies).
- Report **risks** (GMO, MGM, humanized cells, pathogenic germs including herpes virus B, SIV, STLV), viral vectors.
- Surgical exploration and/or an ophthalmological opinion, biological samples and serological examinations may be requested.
- Treatment (antibacterial/antiviral) and vaccination may be offered.

IN ANY CASE

- **Declare the accident** (medical certificate required).
- Inform your safety manager immediately.
- All injuries are to be reported using the occupational health and safety logbook.
- Report all incidents to the **Occupational Health Doctor** for investigation and follow-up.
- Put the biting/scratching animal under a surveillance zone.
- Keep an eye out on the injury to prevent any local or general complication.

PROTECTION MEASURES

- Use the appropriate equipment and carry out the correct maneuvers with the animals and using (gloves, cages, restraint material...).
- Protective gear (collective and individual).
- Respect hygiene rules.
- Condition and medical surveillance of non-human primates.
- Appropriate **information** and **formation** beforehand.
