



IMMEDIATE ACTIONS

In case of cuts, needle pricks or skin splashes

- Wash with soap and water for at least 5 minutes before rinsing.
- Do not scrub or cause any bleeding.
- Inactivate for at least 5 minutes with Dakin's solution (sodium hypochlorite 0.5%, bleach 2.6% diluted active chlorine 1/5).
- Remove any potentially contaminated clothes and place them in a closed plastic bag.

Splashes to eyes

- Rinse thoroughly with plenty of clear running water for at least 5 minutes, hold eyelids wide open, head tilted back and the affected eye looking downwards.

Urgently consult a doctor. Emergency service:

- Contact the antipoison center:
- Identify the toxin, its dosage and maximum concentration.
- Consult a doctor urgently even without any symptoms.
- In case of emergency call SAMU: 15 or 112.

IN ANY CASE

- Declare the accident (medical certificate required).
- Inform your safety manager immediately.
- All injuries are to be reported using the occupational health and safety logbook.
- Report all incidents to the Occupational Health Doctor for investigation and follow-up.

PROTECTION MEASURES

- The requirement of authorisation prior exposition, special register.
- Risk management, biological security/safety, qualification.
- Restricted access.
- Obligatory medical consult prior exposition (medical certificate of non contraindication).
- Appropriate information and formation beforehand.
- Habilitation.
- Respect the proper laboratory rules, tracing manipulations, up to date internal emergency plan.
- Use the personal protective equipment gear.
- Strict hygiene rules, do not drink, eat, smoke or vape.
- Forbid weighing (powder), prefer ready to use material.
- Inactivation/decontamination, waste disposal procedure.
- Declare any incident or accident to the Agence nationale de sécurité du médicament et des produits de santé (ANSM), article R5139-24 du Code de la santé publique.
- Warn of any health change.
- Information of any possible antidote.
