IMMEDIATE ACTIONS

In case of skin splashes

- Rinse with clear water for at least 15 minutes no scrubing.
- Do not neutralize or use products (detergents, cream, etc.).

Splashes in eyes

- **Rinse thoroughly** with plenty of clear running water for at least **5 minutes**, hold eyelids wide open, head tilted back and the affected eye looking downwards.
- Contact lenses tend to get washed away on their own, do not try to manually remove them.
- Do not use any collyre or eye solution.
- · Always consult an ophtalmologist.

In both cases

- Consult a doctor urgently even without any symptoms (identify the product, CAS number, SDS).
- In case of emergency, call:
 - o SAMU (15 or 112),
 - o Firefighters (18),
 - o By SMS for the deaf and hard of hearing (114).

IN ANY CASE

- **Declare the accident** (medical certificate required).
- Inform your **safety manager** immediately.
- All injuries are to be reported using the occupational health and safety logbook.
- Report all incidents to the Occupational Health Doctor for investigation and follow-up.

PROTECTION MEASURES

- It is **essential to handle** chemical products under a **fume hood** (sorbonne).
- Wear protective glasses with side shields, suitable gloves and a closed gown.
