



## IMMEDIATE ACTIONS

### ALERT

- Call the **site emergency number** or **SAMU/CUMP\* 15/112, Police 17**.
- Identify yourself, specify the date, location, type of event, number of people involved, etc.
- Write down the instructions given by the contacted service.
- Indicate the precise coordinates of the site, the security post, and anticipate the arrival of emergency services.
- Alert the unit director or direct hierarchy and the occupational physician.

### VISUALLY PROTECT THE SCENE AND PROTECT YOURSELF

- Use screens, blankets, tables to limit the scene.
- Avoid further accidents.

### SUPPORT FOR DIRECT WITNESSES

- Identify and accompany direct witnesses and colleagues to a quiet place, do not leave them alone (person providing support).
- Identify the most vulnerable people for close monitoring.
- Provide psychological support (listening unit, psychologist, psychiatrist, CUMP).
- Plan internal communication (crisis unit).

## LATER ON

- Ensure that the victim's relatives are contacted.
- Internal communication.
- Communicate with the victim's colleagues.
- Provide support for people who need it.
- Declaration of work accident.
- Exceptional F4SCT (for investigation).

### REMEMBER:

- Hide the victim(s) body from view.
- Alert and accompany the emergency services.
- hear out the witnesses.
- Notify the hierarchy.
- Internal communication.
